Divide Perennials	Season	Months	Indicator	Remarks
Divide/Replant Daylilies	Early Spring/Fall		After Bloom	Dig up entire clump/roots. Divide into units of 2-3 leaves. Replant.
Divide/Replant Daisies	Early Spring/Summer		After Bloom	Dig up entire clump/roots. Seperate bulbs. Replant.
Divide/Replant Iris	Late Summer	July - Sept	After Bloom	4-6 weeks after bloom. Dig up clump, trim leaves, separate new rhizomes from mother, replant
Pinch Back Chrysanthemums	Spring - Mid Summer	Stop in July	New Growth	Trim 2"-3" off shoots @ 4"-6" tall, repeat when shoots @ 6" to 8" tall. Stop in July to allow buds to form
Plant Annuals	Spring	April-May	Last Frost	Garden soil tempreture 60 degrees or better.
Plant Tomatoes	Spring	April-May	Last Frost	Night time tempretures above 55 degrees
Plant Citronella Plants			Last Frost	Night time tempretures above 55 degrees
Plant Dwarf Spruce	Early Spring/Fall			Prepare bed and planting hole in March/April
Trim Yew Bush	Late Winter/Early Spring			Summer after shoots harden.
Trim Eunonymus	Late Winter/Early Spring			Before new growth, out lyers can be pruned
Trim Aborvitae	Mid Spring/Late Winter			Do not trim to bare wood
Prune Oak Tree	Winter	Nov-March		
Overseed Lawn	Early Spring	March/April		Also Late Summer/Early Fall August/October
